Wireless: All 160 schools are equipped with High Density Wireless to support 50 devices per classroom.

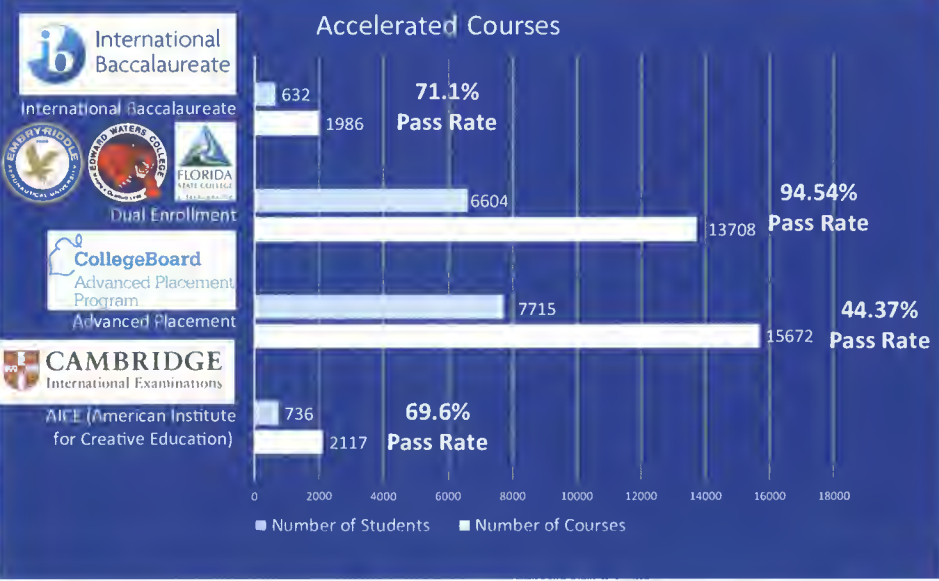
Post-Secondary Readiness at an all time high!

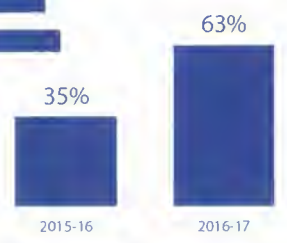

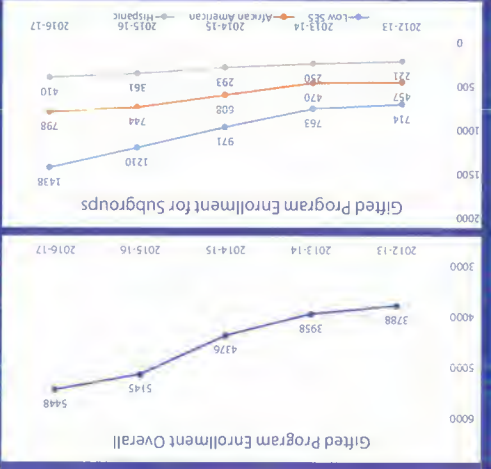

Gifted Program Enrollment has grown 45% over the last five years.

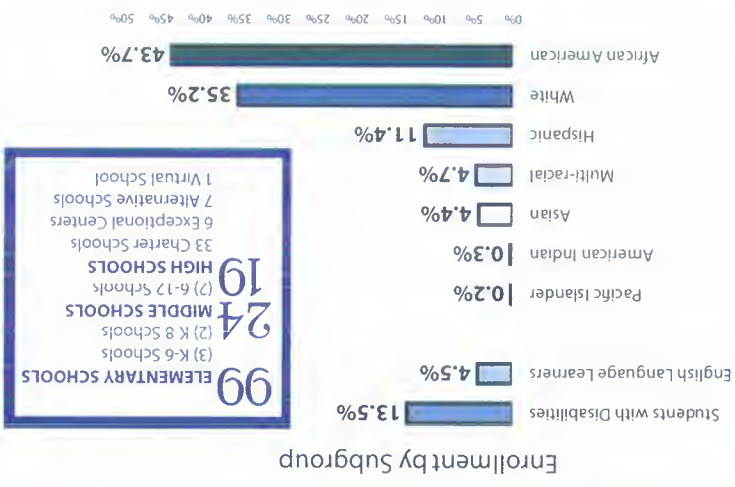

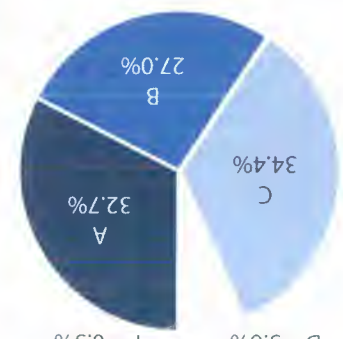

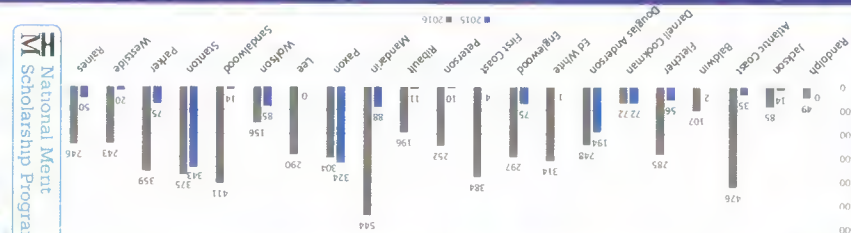
